Present baseline map of brownfields and underutilized land to Brownfield Working Group for feedback.

Kick off community engagement project with Delta Institute.

Underutilized Land Municipality Toolkit Second Half 2019 Create educational resources based on the GIS map and community engagement for municipalities, professionals, developers, and others working with economic development in the region.

Will start after the Brownfields map has been created.
